
Candidates should be provided with the maximum choice of topics, but it is accepted that this may not always be possible. Candidates should be informed of the topic/s available at the earliest opportunity.

## Drawing and/or Painting from a Living Person

Candidates must choose **one** of the options below.

*Candidates should be instructed that, in either question, the relevant parts of the model's surroundings should be considered as part of the study.*

- 1 The model sits astride a bench or a box with both hands, between the knees, resting on the front edge.

*Candidates should be instructed that they are to make a study of the whole figure. They may **also**, if they wish, include studies of other details such as the head or hands. These may be completed on an additional sheet.*

- 2 The model is seated at a small table in front of a wall or a screen, on which paintings, prints or fabrics are displayed. Some art materials are placed on the table and the model holds a brush or a pencil in one hand.

*Candidates should be instructed that they are to make a study of the head and shoulders. They may **also**, if they wish, include studies of other details such as the head or hands. These may be completed on an additional sheet.*
