

Section A: Arabia in the Pre-Islamic period

- 1 (a) Give **four** occupations that were common in Mecca in Pre-Islamic times. [4]
- (b) Give an account of the different ways in which polytheism was practised in Pre-Islamic times. [10]
- (c) 'There were many good features in Arab society during the Pre-Islamic period.'
Discuss this statement and show that you have thought about different points of view. [6]

- 2 (a) Give **four** reasons why the young Muhammad (pbuh) was cared for by Halima. [4]
- (b) What aspects of the character of Muhammad (pbuh) signified that he might be a future prophet? [10]
- (c) 'Muhammad (pbuh) was well supported in his childhood.'
Discuss this statement and show that you have thought about different points of view. [6]

Section B: Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)

- 3 (a) Explain why Abu Bakr needed to rescue Bilal. [4]
- (b) Describe the relationship between Muhammad (pbuh) and Abu Bakr during the Prophet's lifetime. [10]
- (c) 'The support of the early Muslims was important to the mission of Muhammad (pbuh) in Mecca.' Discuss this statement and show that you have thought about different points of view. [6]

- 4 (a) Describe what happened to 'Uthman when the Muslims camped at Hudaibiya. [4]
- (b) Give an account of the terms of the Treaty of Hudaibiya and the reaction of the Muslims to the signing of the Treaty. [10]
- (c) Signing the Treaty of Hudaibiya showed the leadership qualities of the Prophet (pbuh). Discuss how leaders today might follow his example. [6]
